

# Psychologist

## Clinical Psychology

Diagnose and treat mental illness in children, adults, and families. Employed by hospitals, other health service providers, and in private practice.

## Child Psychology

Diagnose and treat disorders that are found predominantly in children. Employed by hospitals, health, and educational organisations, and in private practice.

## Clinical Neuropsychology

Diagnose brain impairment arising from injury, stroke, drug abuse, and so on in adults and children, and help such people develop coping strategies. Employed in hospitals, rehabilitation centres, aged care services, and in private practice.

## Forensic Psychology

Apply psychological knowledge to assist the criminal justice system. Employed by legal services, police services, correctional organisations, community and family services, and in private practice as expert witnesses and consultants.

## Community Psychology

Help people through involvement in community and welfare projects. Employed by local government, welfare agencies and community health organisations.

## Health Psychology

Develop programs to promote health-related behaviour, diagnose causes and correlates of illness, assist people to cope with chronic illness, and work toward the improvement of health services. Employed in hospitals, community health services, and in private practice.

## Teaching & Research Psychology

Teach psychology to undergraduate and postgraduate students, supervise research, and develop and conduct independent research. Also conduct research in other organisations such as hospitals, acoustic laboratories, accident prevention bodies, and so on.

## Sports Psychology

Apply psychological knowledge to the understanding of factors which influence sporting performance and which result from sporting involvement. Employed by individual sporting organisations, clubs, and government organisations, and in private practice.

## Educational Psychology

Diagnose and treat learning disabilities in adults and children. Employed by State education departments and in private practice.

## Organisational Psychology

Help people to function optimally in the work place, understand the processes operating in work places, personnel selection and training, and marketing and advertising. Employed by commercial corporations, government bodies, and in private consulting.

## Counselling Psychology

Assist people coping with problems which are related to general well-being, work, personal relationships, and short-term crisis intervention. Employed by community and health organisations, welfare agencies, and in private practice.
