Seniors Discount Policy

PREAMBLE

St. Albert's College is an independent Catholic College at the University and seeks to:

1. Enhance the personal development and academic development of the individual.
2. Foster excellence in all university activities.
3. Promote Christian values in a Catholic environment.
4. Foster independence of thought and service to the community.

To achieve this, it is important that the College contains senior students who are able to provide a positive role model for the younger students. At the same time it is important that all students are aware that there are consequences when a student fails to be a suitable role model.

POLICY

- 1.1. As a reward to all returning senior students who are in at least their 3rd year of College, there is a possible 5% discount on their fees.
- 1.2. To qualify for the discount a student must be a suitable role model for the College. A suitable role model fulfils all of the following conditions, they:
 - Have an overall GPA of 4 or more at the start of the year.
 - Maintain a semester GPA of 3.6 (pass average) or more during the year.
 - Have their previous College fees fully paid at the start of each term.
 - Are a role model to freshers in terms of their behaviour and participation in the College.
 - Assist the College in its leadership of the College by either:
 - Holding a leadership position in the College.
 - Supporting their Floor RA and PA with the management of the floor.
 - Supporting the College's leadership in overall College life.
- 1.3. If a student fails one or more of the conditions of being a role model during the year the discount would be discontinued.

PROCEDURES

1. Each student qualifying for the discount must complete an "Application for the Seniors Discount Form". By signing the form the senior student.
 - a. Verifies that they qualify for the discount and
 - b. Agrees to the conditions of their Role Modelling.
2. The discount is not backdated and the deadlines for applications to be received are:

3. The College Office will assess and approve the application, with the following people assessing the conditions of the discount:
 - The Master – Academic
 - The Dean – Position and Role Modelling
 - The Bursar - Finance.
4. The Master, Dean and Bursar will continue to assess the conditions of the discount throughout the year. The discount will be removed at any time during the year, if the student's:
 - semester GPA falls below 3.6 (they obtain an F1 or F2 average).
 - fees are unpaid at the end of each term.
 - role modelling is deemed as unacceptable.
5. The discount will cease from the date at which they are assessed to have failed one or more of the conditions of the discount.
6. A student who loses their discount may appeal against the decision, by writing to the Master, outlining how they are fulfilling the conditions of the discount. The decision of the Master is final.
7. A student who loses their discount in a given term, may reapply for the discount after a period of one term without the discount.

DURATION

This policy comes into effect in November 2008 and will be reviewed by November 2011.
