Homestay

In addition to on-campus accommodation, UNE English Language Centre offers homestay. Homestay allows participants to experience the Australian way of life in Armidale's friendly community as well as providing the best environment in which to learn native-speaker English. The experience of living with an Australian family results in many students and homestay families regularly keeping in contact with each other, years after their program has ended. All homestay families are carefully screened and interviewed in their homes by UNE International Services staff and all family members are required to complete a yearly Federal police check.





Program Design and Costs

Our programs are customised to the specific requirements of our participants. The costs depend on the content of each program. Study tours can take place at any time of the year and can be from two to eight weeks duration. Program fees include:

- Pre-departure information package
- Meet and greet at Armidale Airport
- Transport to and from Airport to University
- Orientation for all students, including a tour of UNE and Armidale
- Language assessment test
- Homestay and/or on-campus accommodation
- Transport to and from excursions and activities
- Day visits to local schools and other places of cultural interest

- Wireless network on campus
- UNE student card
- Resource materials
- Support and supervision for students during the program
- Attendance Certificate
