SUPPORT OF NON-HDR STUDENT PROJECTS - FEBRUARY 2008

SUPPORT FOR HONOURS AND OTHER STUDENT RESEARCH PROJECTS FROM SCHOOL OF ENVIRONMENTAL AND RURAL SCIENCE

Honours students and those undertaking a project unit as part of a coursework degree will be eligible for support for their projects for a variety of items, such as equipment, materials, fieldwork and conference attendance. Funds cannot be used for expenses related to producing theses or reports.

A maximum of \$1500 will be available for full-time (48 cp) Honours projects. The level of support for other research projects will depend on the proportion of the year's full-time work (e. g. \$750 for 24 cps, \$375 for 12 cps, etc).

Academic staff are strongly encouraged to embed non-HDR projects into existing research projects and minimise the drawn on School funds.

Applications for funds should be submitted by the supervisor and student jointly, and include a project title, budget, brief justification and details of any other financial support promised for the project (max 200 words). Applications will be submitted to the Academic Administrative Officer (Ms Karen Morris).

Purpose: the School policy for support of non-HDR student projects is intended to remove limitations to taking on non-HDR student projects
