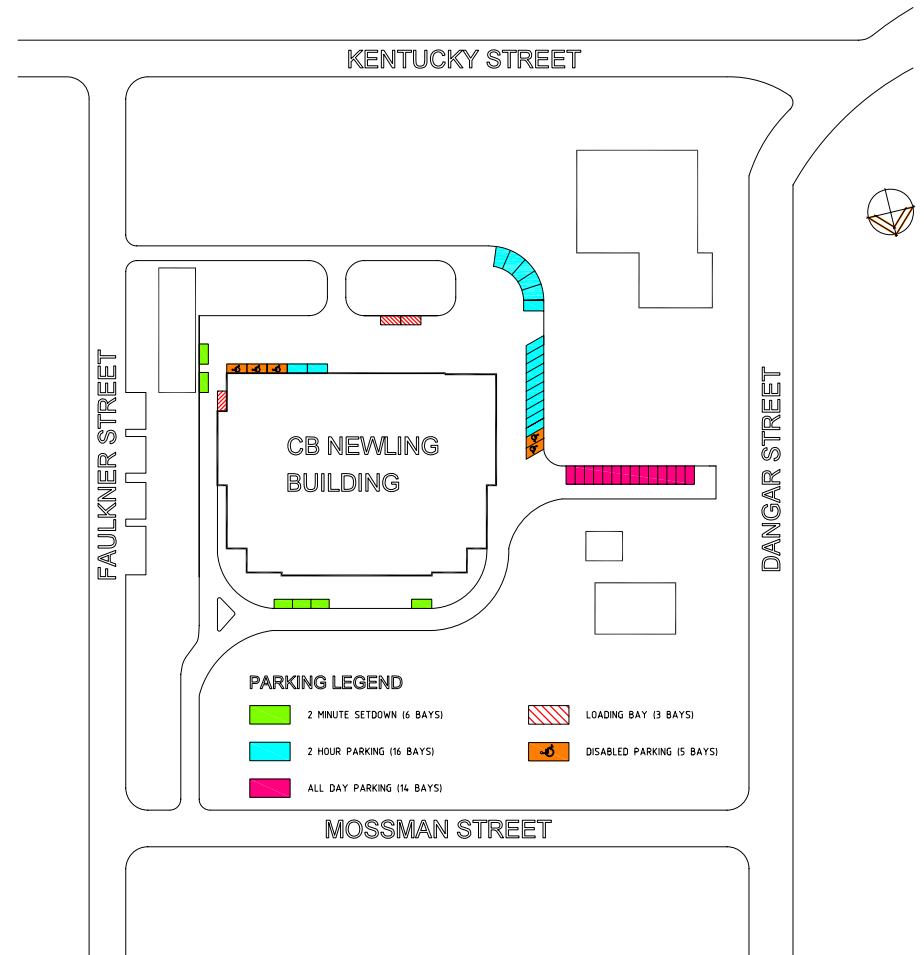


Parking at C.B. Newling



Parking at C B Newling

- C B Newling now operates as a Restricted Parking Area under RTA Motor Traffic Regulations 1935, relating to Regulations 2(1), 54 (6) (ao) 10A (1) (g) & 54 (7).
- The Restricted Parking Area is defined by traffic control signs displayed adjacent to the entrance & exits of the C B Newling precinct.
- Under the Restricted Parking Regulation, standing, waiting or parking of motor vehicles is prohibited at any place within the precinct, except when parked in designated parking bays.
- Parking bays – In relation to a Restricted Parking Area, means that portion of a Restricted Parking Area in which a vehicle may park which is delineated by lines and or bump stops.
- Penalty Notices will be issued for any parking offence committed by motorists in respect of parking restriction relating to a Restricted Parking Area.
- Short-term parking is available in 2 minute, & 2 hour bays located around the C B Newling precinct.
- All day parking is available in the 8 hour parking bays located to the west of the C B Newling building.
- When loading and unloading goods, vehicles can park in loading bays for 30 minutes.
- On street parking in Mossman St, Dangar St, Kentucky St & Faulkner St is not considered part of the C B Newling Restricted Parking Area.
- **You must not park in or on the following places no matter how convenient it seems:**
 - Grassed areas
 - At either the Front or Rear steps to the Main Building
 - Outside marked bays
 - Footpaths
 - Service vehicle areas
 - Any area that signage is not erected permitting you to park

Please note:

- Even if there is no sign in place indicating that parking is not permitted (i.e. No Stopping) you must not park there.
- You park your vehicle at your own risk. It is your responsibility to ensure that your vehicle is locked and that no valuable items are left in your vehicle.
- UNE accepts no responsibility for cars parked at C B Newling.
- Disabled Bays are for the exclusive use of vehicles that display an RTA approved Mobility Permit.
- Parking in Green Permit bays is restricted to UNE & Contractor vehicles that display a current UNE Green Permit.
- Appeals against the issuing of Penalty Notices are processed on behalf of the University of New England by the Infringement Processing Bureau an arm of the State Debt Recovery Office. Appeals must be lodged within 21 days of the date issued. The address to lodge an appeal is:
