The following units offered in previous years LING312 (Phonology and Pronunciation), LING313 (Language Description), LING360 (Analysing Syntax) and LING368 (Formal Phonology) also satisfy this requirement. With the permission of the Head of the School of Behavioural, Cognitive and Social Sciences up to 12 credit points of Linguistics may be substituted by units in another relevant discipline. 	<p>Note the additional requirement amendment</p> <p>These course rule changes only apply to students who commence or transfer to 2010 course rules</p>
