Addition of new compulsory unit LS101 (Law in Context) 	<p><i>For Students beginning study in semester one 2009</i> Will follow the 2009 Bachelor of Laws course rules</p> <p><i>Current students who began in 2008 or earlier</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students should note that LS210 is a compulsory requirement under the pre 2009 rules and will be available for the last time in semester 2 2009. Students who do not successfully complete LS210 before it is withdrawn must undertake both new units (LS111 and LS212) and one fewer elective. Students also have the option of transferring to the new course rules in which case they would also need to successfully complete LS101.
