<p>The Graduate Diploma in Counselling has been replaced with the Graduate Diploma in Counselling for Health and Social Care</p> <p>The following units have been withdrawn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Core units: HSCS452, HSCS462</li> <li>• Elective units: HSCS472, HSCS474, HSCS475, HSCS478, HSCS512</li> </ul> <p>New and/or units with code change:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• HSCS405 is now HSMH421 Foundational Counselling and Assessment Skills</li> <li>• HSMH422 Introduction to Mental Health Care</li> <li>• HSMH423 Evidence-Based Practice in Mental Health</li> <li>• HSMH424 Mental Health Promotion, Prevention, Intervention</li> </ul>	<p>Students currently enrolled in the Graduate Diploma in Counselling will be invited to transfer to the Graduate Diploma in Counselling for Health and Social Care</p> <p>Students who do not wish to transfer will be individually advised as to which units they will need to take in order to complete the degree</p> <p>The current Graduate Diploma in Counselling will be awarded until the end of 2010 to those students who only need to complete up to two units in 2010</p> <p>Students who have completed HSCS462 will be given advanced standing for another unit in the revised award and those needing to complete this unit will be advised as to which alternative unit they need to take in its place</p>
