If you do not complete by this date you will be required to transfer into the 72 credit point Graduate Diploma in Education in 2010 and will receive advanced standing for all of the units you have successfully completed.</p> <p>Students who commenced in 2008 under the requirement to undertake 60 days of professional experience may choose to undertake 45 days of professional experience in order to satisfy the requirements of the course. If you have not already completed all of your professional experience units all you will need to do is complete an additional 5 days in either PREX901 (previously ED901) or PREX902 (previously ED902). If you have already successfully completed ED901 and ED902 you will need to enrol in PREX900 and complete 5 days professional experience.</p>
