Guidelines for the Bachelor of Business component

96 credit points from:

- AFM 101, AFM112, ECON 101, ECON102, ECON 243, MM 105, MM 110, MM 200 and QM 161 (60 cps);
- not more than 36 credit points at 100 level; the units from at least one of the majors below and listed in Schedule 2 of the Faculty of Economics, Business and Law, provided that any unit included shall count only towards the business component of the combined degree (36 cps).

A Business Major is one of the following:

- (i) **Agribusiness:** ECON121, ECON223, ECON203/303 or ECON230/330; plus three units from: ECON333, ECON334, ECON335, ECON336; Note: at least three units must be undertaken at 300 level;
- (ii) **Business Economics:** QM262; ECON 201, 202; plus three units from ECON303, 307, 311, 317, 319, 324, 328, 329; GEPL301. Include at least 3 units at 300 level
- (iii) **Decision Support Tools for Business:** QM262, QM265/365, QM267/367; Plus three units from: ECON271/371, ECON326, ECON334, ECON375, ECON376, ECON377, MATH170, NEBS305, 306; QM264/364; Note: At least three units must be at 300 level;
- (iv) **Financial Management:** AFM231, 232, plus at least four units from AFM 202, 272, 312, 316, 322, 324, 331, 332, 334, 335, 372; EBUS201; ECON203/303, 319, 334. Note: At least two units must be at 300 level;
- (v) **Human Resource Management:** NEBS305; MM220, 321; ECON 251/351; plus one unit from: MM223/323, 300, 320, 322; ECON207; NEBS306; THEA110; WGST320; Note: at least two units must be at 300 level;
- (vi) **International Business:** ECON142, 245/345; MM202/302; and three units from: AFM335; ECON241, 245/345, 246/346, 248/348, 249/349, 250/350, 320, 335, 353, 354; LS293, MM318; Any 6cp language unit at 200/300 level. Note: at least two units must be at 300 level;
- (vii) **Marketing:** MM213/313, 214/314, 311, 316; NEBS305 plus one unit from EBUS201; MM318, 322; NEBS306; THEA110. Note: three units must be at 300 level.
