

BACHELOR OF ARTS/BACHELOR OF TEACHING—DEGREE PLANNER 2007

Overview

The combined degree totals 192 cp. The Arts component comprises 96 cp and the Teaching component comprises 96 cp. Students are required to complete at least 48 cp of the Arts component before incorporating units from the Teaching component.

A major area of study in one teaching subject area (12 cp at 100-level, 12 cp at 200/300-level and 12 cp at 300-level) and a minor area of study in a second teaching subject area (12 cp at 100-level, 12 cp at 200/300-level) are undertaken in the Arts component of the award. Students should note that where their first and second teaching subject areas combine Human Society and Its Environment (HSIE) with a non-HSIE area, they will need to complete both teaching subject areas to 300-level. Please check with the Student Centre regarding teaching subject combinations.

Subject Areas

Subject areas include: Aboriginal Studies (HSIE), Asian Studies (HSIE), Drama (Theatre Studies), Economics (HSIE), English, Geography (HSIE), History (HSIE), Linguistics, Modern Languages, Politics (HSIE), Sociology (HSIE), Studies in Religion (HSIE).

Students must complete two combinations of the subject areas listed above, one as a major and one as a minor, in order to gain a secondary teaching qualification. A third subject area or studies in a complementary subject to these may also be completed. There are three options for completing the degree: Option One: one major and one minor; Option Two: a double major and Option Three: a double major and a minor. Please refer to the course rules in your Education booklet for advice on what is the best option for you.

The degree planners which follow are suggested patterns of enrolment for full-time candidates. Part-time students should note unit pre-requisites when selecting their units each year.

Must complete a Major (36 cp) sequence of units (12 cp at 100-level, 12 cp at 200-level and 12 cp at 300-level or equivalent) in one teaching subject area and a Minor (24 cp) sequence of units (12 cp at 100-level and 12 cp at 200 or 300-level) in a second teaching subject area. Must complete 36 cp elective units.

Students are not permitted to complete more than 48 cp at 100-level in the Arts component of the course.
