

## BACHELOR OF BUSINESS/BACHELOR OF ECONOMICS—DEGREE PLANNER 2007

This degree planner is to be used as a guide and is not necessarily the only way to complete the program. All compulsory units from the core have been listed. Each major, except for the Professional Accounting and Financial Management majors, has a set of compulsory units and a number of elective units which must be completed. The unfilled places in the following table should be filled by units from the majors and the six electives in the program. Student may wish to include units from their majors in second year.

### Course Requirements

To qualify for the degree, a student must pass units to the value of 192 cp comprising:

(a) compulsory units to the value of 84 cp: AFM 101, 112; COMP 100; ECON 101, 102, 201, 202; either\*: ECON 143 and MATH 170 or ECON 143 and MATH 101 or MATH 101 and MATH 102; MM 105, 110, 200; QM 161, 162.

(b) one of the following Business majors to the value of 36 cp:

- Agribusiness;
- Business Economics;
- Decision Support Tools for Business;
- Financial Management;
- Hospitality and Tourism (Blue Mountains students only);
- Human Resource Management;
- International Business;
- Management;
- Marketing;
- Professional Accounting.

(c) one of the Economic majors to the value of 36 cp of which at least 18 cp must be at 300 level.

**Economics**

ECON 224, 311, 317, 328 Plus two units from: ECON 103, 203/303, 207/307, 216/316, 226/326, 230/330, 246/346, 271/371, 314, 319, 329, 353; GEPL301.

**Econometrics**

ECON 271 plus five units from: ECON 226/326, 334, 374, 375, 376, 377; QM 264/364, 265/365, 267/367.

**Economic History**

Select six units from: ECON 141/241, 142, 216/316, 245/345, 246/346, 248/348, 249/349, 250/350, 251/351, 314, 353.

(d) other units to provide the total of 192 cp for the combined degrees. These units must be from Schools of the Faculty of Economics, Business and Law, as detailed in the Schedule of Units and/or units approved by the course coordinator, from Schools outside the Faculty.

(e) units at 300 level to the value of 48cp.

(f) units to the value of not more than 84 cp at 100 level.

(g) the majors listed below are restricted and students may complete only one of (a) and only one of (b) and only one of (c) towards the requirements for the combined degree of Bachelor of Business/of Economics. For example, a student who selects (b) Business Economics as the major for the Business component, may not take (b) Economics as the major in the of Economics component.

- (b) Business Economics
- (c) International Business

**Bachelor of Economics major**

- (a) Econometrics
- (b) Economics
- (c) Economic History

**Units Required to Meet Professional Requirements**

In order to satisfy the educational requirements for admission to the major professional accounting bodies, completion of a number of specific units is required. They can be completed by choosing the Professional Accounting major in the Business component of the combined degree.
