TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

The Prize

1. The Prize shall comprise a payment of one year's college* fees to the value of \$7,500 including accommodation, weekly-cleaning, linen services, internet and phone connection. Catering options are also available for colleges with flexible catering. The price difference is not redeemable in any form.
2. The Prize is payable directly into the Prize winner's residential account in two equal installments, after each semester census date.
3. The Prize does not include travel, transfers or parking.
4. The Prize value is correct at time of publication, but the University takes no responsibility for any variation in the value of the Prize.

Eligibility

5. To be eligible to win the Prize, you must become a full-time on-campus student at UNE, commencing in Semester One, 2010. You must remain enrolled as a full-time on-campus student for both Semester One and Semester Two, 2010.
6. "Full-time" is defined for this purpose as being enrolled in 4 on-campus units each semester.
7. The Prize will be offered only to first year students who are new to UNE. Previous and continuing students are ineligible.
8. Students receiving UNE scholarships will not be eligible.
9. University of New England staff members and their immediate families are not eligible for entry.
10. Entrants under 18 years of age must have consent from a parent or guardian.
11. Only one entry per person is allowed. The person entering must be the person who receives the Prize. (i.e. family or friends cannot enter on your behalf).

The Process

12. The competition commences on Tuesday 18/8/2009 at 9.00am and closes on Friday 11/9/2009 12.00pm.
13. Entry into the competition is by placing a completed form into the competition box located at either the UNE Open Day or AgQuip Information events.
14. The first randomly drawn entry containing a fully completed registration form will receive the Prize.
15. UNE will make reasonable attempts to contact the Prize winner by email or phone.
16. The Prize winner will be notified by 18 September 2009.
17. The Prize must be accepted within 3 months of notification and is subject to availability.

Legal Stuff

18. The Prize is not transferable and cannot be taken as cash or used in conjunction with any other offer.
19. The decision of the University is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

20. The University of New England will not be held responsible for the loss of the Prize** after it has been awarded, or for any injury that results directly or indirectly from this promotion.
21. If for any reason this promotion is not capable of running as planned, the University of New England reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the promotion.
