

Academic Staff Promotion

Changes in 2009

- Pro Vice-Chancellor and Dean no longer involved in initial consultation on applications.
- Student evaluation reports are now available from the Evaluations Officer, Planning and Institutional Research.
- Student evaluation reports are now exclusive of application page limit.
- Application summary is now a separate document.
- Clauses relating to evidence of quality of research have been revised (14.01.23 – 14.01.26), including the requirement to indicate and describe applicant's most significant publications (up to ten).
- Applicants now provide the Head of School with a list of potential assessors. Head of School will then select from this pool and obtain agreement from each assessor (see clauses 14.01.30 to 14.01.34).
- There will be one Promotion Committee only.
- Membership of the Promotion Committee will consist of:
 - Vice-Chancellor (Chair and member – Level E only)
 - Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Chair, Levels B, C, D and member, Level E)
 - Faculty Pro Vice-Chancellors and Dean
 - Chair or Deputy Chair of the Academic Board
 - Four continuing academics (two elected from each Faculty, one at Level C or above and one at Level D or above.)
 - One External Professor (not necessarily the same for each level)
 - For research-only staff the Pro Vice-Chancellor (Research) will be a member.
