

Research Income by HERDC Categories

Applicants are encouraged to indicate whether or not grants listed under Section 3.1 of the Promotion Application form are competitive or non-competitive in nature – the following HERDC categories will assist.

Category 1: Australian Competitive Grants

- Commonwealth Competitive Research Funding and other Non-Commonwealth Competitive Research Schemes.

Category 2: Other Public Sector Research Funding

- any other research funding received from the Commonwealth not listed under Australian Competitive Grants;
- research funding from Commonwealth Government Business Enterprises;
- research funding (including contract research) from both State and Local Governments;
- research funding from State Government Business Enterprises; and
- funding from partly Government owned or funded bodies (eg Telstra, or Cooperative Research Centres in which the reporting university is not a partner).

Category 3: Industry and other Funding for Research

National:

- contract research funding provided by industry or other non-Government agencies (including industry financial contributions to Linkage Grants);
 - grants for research from other than Governments;
 - donations and bequests for research from Australian business, Australian non-profit organisations, and Australian individuals; and
 - income received from syndicated research & development arrangements.
- International:
- contract research provided by non-Australian industry or non-Australian Government agencies including non-Australian industry collaborative research grants;
 - grants for research from non-Australian industry or non-Australian Government agencies including non-Australian industry collaborative research grants; and
 - donations and bequests for research from non-Australian business, non-Australian non-profit organisations, and non-Australian individuals.

Category 4: Cooperative Research Centre Funding

Funding from Cooperative Research Centre (CRC's) in which the reporting university is not a participant should be included in as Other Public Sector Income rather than CRC income.
