



## NEW DEGREE: GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN HISTORY CURRICULUM

From 2011, a **Graduate Certificate in History Curriculum** degree will be offered at the University of New England.

The degree will assist K-10 teachers nationwide prepare for the History component of the new Australian Curriculum. This full on-line course is aimed at current primary teachers and secondary history teachers wishing to upgrade their professional qualifications and up-skill for the new curriculum.

The Graduate Certificate comprises four units that have been specifically devised by UNE's Schools of Humanities and Education and include both pedagogical and practical components. Course duration is one year part time (maximum two years). The units are:

- (a) hold a three or four year pre-service teaching qualification of a recognized University; or
- (b) hold a bachelor degree and a one or two year pre-service teaching qualification of a recognized University; or
- (c) comply with the University's English Language requirements.
