**HUMS 301: Special Option A; HUMS 302: Special Option B; HUMS 303: Special Option C;

These units are designed to allow students to pursue supervised individual research interests or to undertake an agreed program of study.

Assessment: 2 x 3000 word essays OR 1 x 6000 word essay and one annotated bibliography or other requirements in consultation with the supervisor [assessment is flexible in consultation with the supervisor].

Postgraduate:

HUMS 505: Reading Unit A; HUMS 506: Reading Unit B

These units are designed to allow students to pursue supervised individual research interests or to undertake an agreed program of study. ***If candidature in the Master of Arts, reading course topic must be in the same area of study as the nominated major sequence.***

Assessment: 2 x 3500 word essays OR 1 x 7000 word essay and one annotated bibliography or other requirements in consultation with the supervisor [assessment is flexible in consultation with the supervisor].

HUMS 507: Minor Research Project

This unit is designed to allow students to pursue research interests. Students will work with a member of staff to design, conduct and present a minor research project. ***If candidature in the Master of Arts, reading course topic must be in the same area of study as the nominated major sequence.***

Assessment: 1 x 7000 word essay and one annotated bibliography or in consultation with supervisor.

HUMS 508: Major Research Project

This unit is designed to allow students to pursue research interests. Students will work with a member of staff to design, conduct and present a major research project. ***If candidature in the Master of Arts, reading course topic must be in the same area of study as the nominated major sequence.***

Assessment: 1 x 12000 word essay and one annotated bibliography or in consultation with supervisor.

Please read the following information before you complete this form.

1. Ensure you meet the prerequisite requirements for the HUMS units which are:
300-level: Any 24 cp
500-level:
HUMS505 and HUMS506: Candidature in a postgraduate award and Credit GPA in 24 at 300 level or 12 cp at 400/500 level within the same area of study as the intended reading course and permission of relevant Head of School
HUMS507: any 12 cp at 500-level and permission of head of school
HUMS508: Candidature in a postgraduate award and Distinction GPA in 24 at 300 level or 12 cp at 400/500 level within the same area of study as the intended reading course, or permission of Head of School or candidature in GradDipLocFamAppHist and HIST595 and permission of head of school
2. Contact a potential supervisor to negotiate unit content
3. If you are using a HUMS 300-level unit to undertake work normally offered under another unit number eg. HIST 368 you are advised to be in your last year of candidature and ensure that the original unit is not offered in the same academic year.
4. It is recommended that the Minor and Major Research Project units [HUMS 507 and 508 respectively] be done towards the end of your award.
5. Candidates are only permitted to enrol in each of the HUMS units once.
