# non-award accounting and law units

UNE offers individual units of study in Accounting and Law for overseas trained professionals who wish to practise in Australia. The majority of non-award law and accounting units are offered in one semester per year – either first semester (February - June) or second semester (July - November). Students should check unit commencement dates before submitting an application. A limited number of accounting and law units are also available in Summer Semester which runs over university summer holidays, November - January.

## accounting

The entry requirements for CPA Australia, Institute of Chartered Accountants Australia (ICAA) and the National Institute of Accountants (NIA) can be satisfied by completing individual units of study at UNE.

Candidates should apply to CPA Australia, ICAA or NIA for a written assessment of their particular education program for membership (please note that fees may apply for these assessments).

Students who need to complete a number of units should also consider UNE programs including the Diploma of Commerce (an 8 unit degree in which candidates are able to enrol in any combination of units, suitable for students who need to complete additional units for CPA, NIA or ICAA recognition), Graduate Diploma in Financial Management and the Master of Business Administration (Professional Accounting). These qualifications are accredited graduate conversion programs for CPA, ICAA and NIA registration.

## law

UNE offers bridging courses for overseas trained Legal Practitioners who wish to practise law in New South Wales, Australia. A person who has attained legal qualifications overseas is required to apply for recognition of qualifications to the New South Wales Legal Profession Admission Board.

The Board will assess the qualification and recommend a course of study that will enable admission to practice Law in New South Wales. Further information on overseas recognised qualifications and how to apply can be found through the following link:

# Application and Admission Information

*Fees* Non-award accounting and law units are AUD1530 each.

*Examinations* Some non-award units require students to sit a final exam as part of unit assessment. Examinations for international distance students are held at nominated overseas centres, and students are required to travel up to 300km to an exam centre and are also liable for a cost of AUD200 per examination. Distance students are advised by letter of the date, time and place of their examinations, approximately eight weeks prior to the commencement of the examination period.
