ELIGIBILITY

1. All UNE students eligible for exchange programs or approved overseas language study for UNE credit, may apply for an exchange scholarship, except:
 - a. Those granted another scholarship for the same purpose worth more than \$2000.¹
 - b. Those who have previously been awarded a scholarship under this scheme. However, students who apply for two *separate* one-semester exchanges (i.e. to two different universities and/or countries) may apply again, for their second exchange, if they were unsuccessful the first time.
2. Applicants (other than students studying OSLS units – see point 3) must qualify for a UNE exchange program² or other overseas study approved for credit at UNE³, and must have submitted a complete exchange application, including personal statement and references, by the advertised deadline.
3. Students studying OSLS units must have been approved to study OSLS391 and/or OSLS392 by the School of Languages, Cultures and Linguistics, and must attach the following documents to accompany their application:
 - a. A personal statement of approximately 500 words, describing their personal and academic aims for the overseas study and the qualities that would make them a good UNE ambassador overseas.

AWARD CRITERIA

1. Scholarships will be awarded based upon academic performance⁴

DUE DATES

Applications must be submitted to International Marketing & Pathways before the 31st March for semester two exchanges and 30th September for semester one exchanges. Late applications will not be accepted.

DECLARATION

¹ This does not preclude students from also benefiting from loans such as the proposed OS-Help scheme

² Criteria include successfully completing the equivalent of a year of university study, meeting current International Office and Faculty standards for exchanges, being currently enrolled at UNE and exchanging with an overseas institution with which UNE has a current, formal exchange agreement.

³ Eligible programs include any approved overseas study which can be credited towards UNE courses, with an approved partner institution or other course provider, as approved by the relevant school. All applicants must receive credit for the majority of their units in order to be eligible.

⁴ Results will be averaged on this scale: Pass=1, Credit=2, Distinction=3 and High Distinction=4; marks less than a pass receive no value. Students must normally achieve at least 2.0 on this 4.0 scale.
