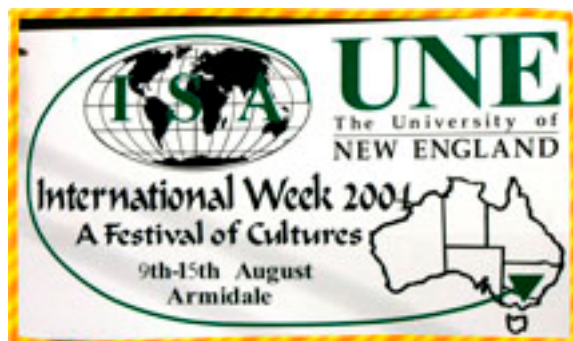


ISA President's Message
