Who We Are

The University of New England International Students' Association (ISA) is an organisation of international students within the UNE, established by the UNE-ISA Constitution.

Our Aims Objectives

The aims and objectives of the ISA are to:

- promote and represent the intellectual, material, social, sporting and cultural interests of international students enrolled at the University at local, state and national level and matters incidental thereto;
- assist international students adjusting to the Australian system of education;
- support and encourage international affairs and activities within the University;
- promote cultural diversity, friendship, understanding and awareness amongst overseas students and Australians;
- work and liaise with other like organisations;
- liaise and cooperate with appropriate bodies of the University and local community for the benefit of international students;
- exercise a general oversight and support of affiliated international student clubs/associations/groups;
- be part of the general student movement at local, state and national level.

Members

All internal international students officially enrolled at the UNE are automatically members of ISA. This includes full time students and exchange students. LTC and TAFE international students as well as friends and dependants of UNE international students may apply for ISA associate membership.

Activities

ISA organises a number of activities that aim to enhance cultural enrichments among international students, local students, the University staff and local community. Such activities include:

Social gatherings/sports, Coach trip, annual presentation of International Week, which features a cultural exhibition, an international food fair, an international film night and multi-cultural concert.



Representation

As an international students' body, ISA represents members' interests to various organisation and bodies within UNE and the Armidale community. At the state and federal level, ISA is an affiliate of the National Liaison Committee for international Students in Australia Incorporated (NLC). The goal of the NLC is to be the peak representative body for all international students in Australia. Through its representations, campaigns and/or lobbying, the NLC advocates the rights of international students on a state and national level.

ISA Council

Apart from the Executive Committee, a Council also governs ISA. The Council is responsible for developing the policies of the Association pertaining to matters relevant to the interests of international students. (Check out on how you can be a member of the ISA Council.)
