

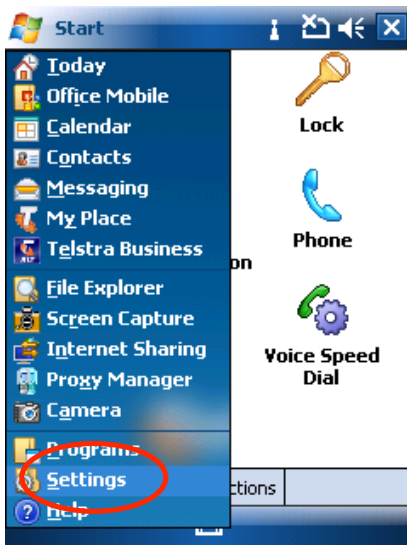
Connecting to UNE wireless using Windows Mobile PDA's & Smartphones

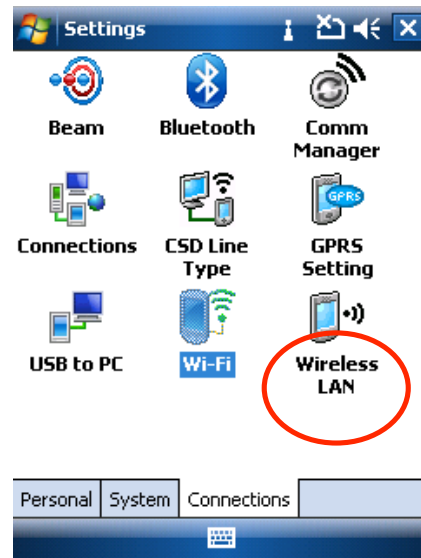
Make sure you have installed SecureW2 for Windows Mobile from here:

1) Click on Start, go to 'Settings'

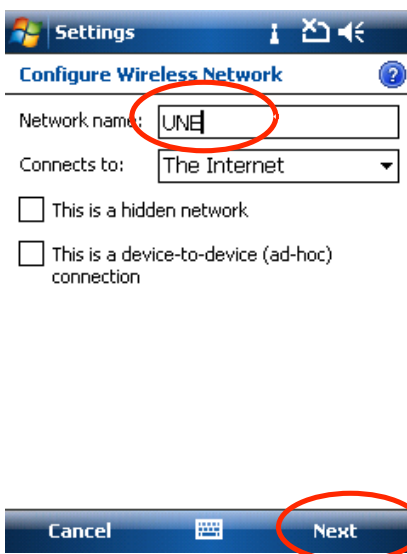


2) Go to Connections, Choose 'Wi-Fi'

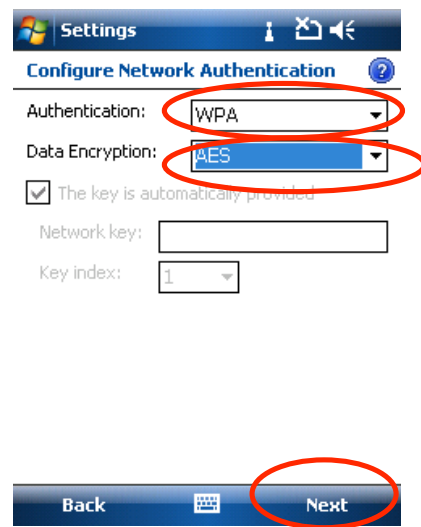


3) Click on 'Add New...'

Put in UNE for the Network Name, click Next



4) Set Authentication to WPA & Encryption to AES (or TKIP if your device doesn't have AES), click Next

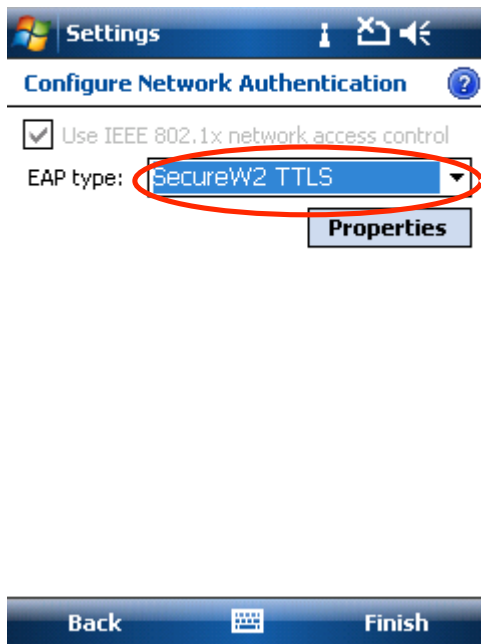


5) Set EAP type to "SecureW2 TTLS"

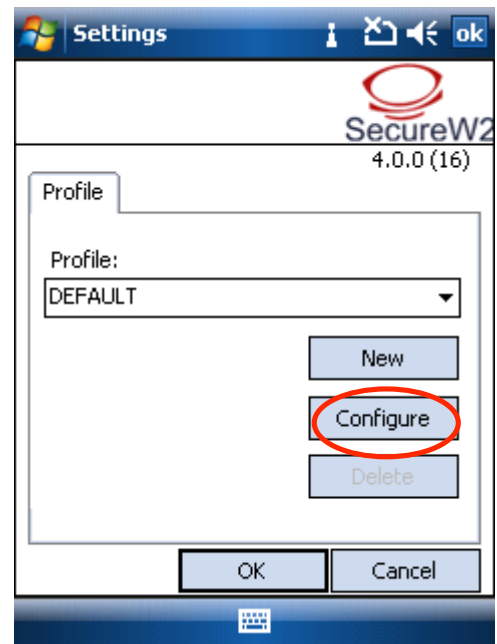
Click on 'Properties'

If "SecureW2 TTLS" is not listed, you need to install SecureW2 for Windows Mobile available here:

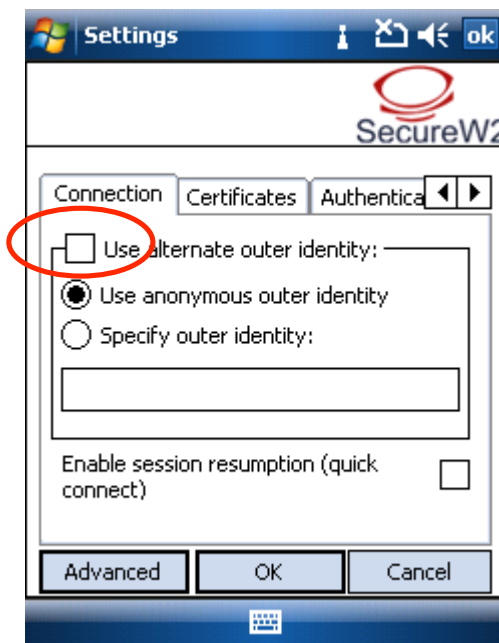

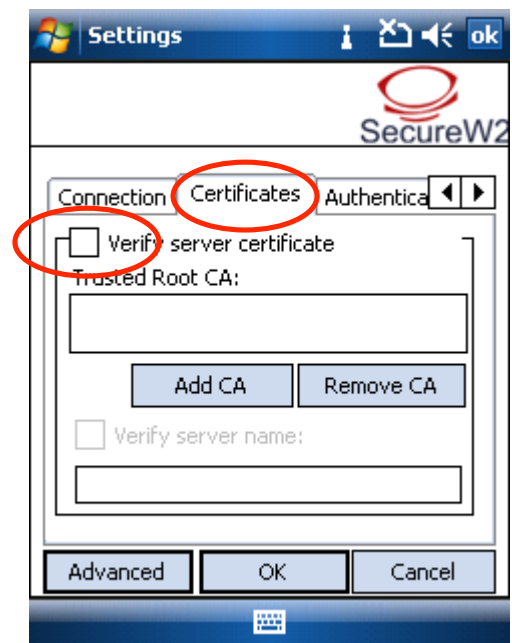
6) Click On 'Configure'



7) Untick 'Use alternate outer identity'

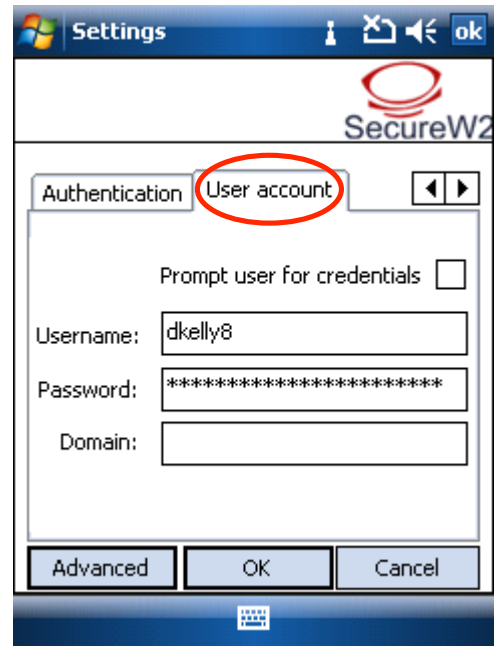
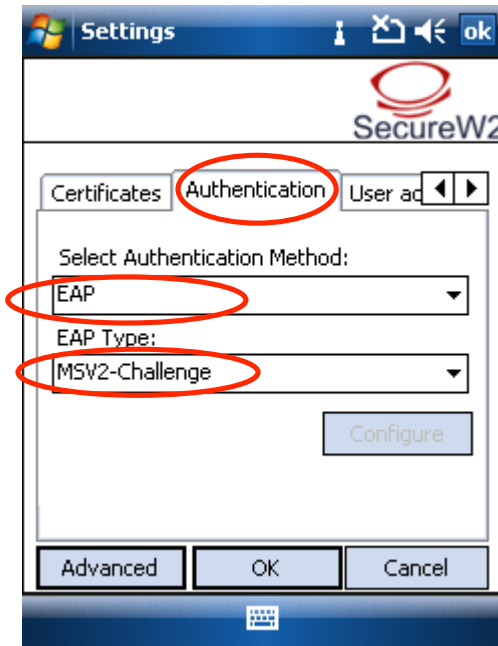


8) Untick 'Verify Server Certificate'

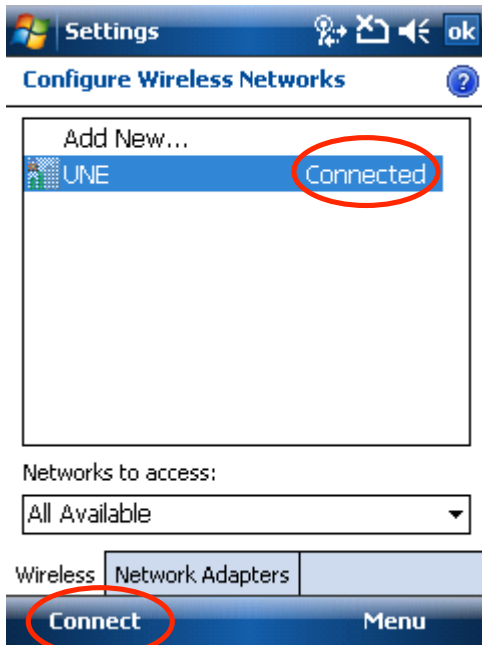


9) Set Authentication to EAP
Set EAP type to MSV2-Challenge
Finish.

10) Enter your UNE username & password
(leave Domain blank), Press OK, Press
