

Permission to access the internet for UNE students under the age of 18

In 1999 amendments made to the 1992 Broadcasting Service Amendment, it states that “internet access accounts are not provided to persons under the age of 18 years without the consent of a parent, teacher or other responsible adult”.

UNE will provide access to University online resources (such as email, online library resources, online teaching material) to all students, regardless of age. However, the University will restrict general internet access for those students under the age of 18. Any student under the age of 18 who wishes to obtain access to the internet must ensure that the agreement form below is signed by their parent or guardian and is returned in mail or in person to the Information Technology Directorate. On receipt of the form, UNE will enable general internet access on the same day.
