

Becoming a member

Membership of the UNE Landcare group is open to all students and staff of the University of New England, and members of the Armidale and surrounding community. *To become a member, simply come along to any working bee or General Meeting of the UNE Landcare group.* From the homepage, follow the links to find out dates for meetings, working bees and other events.

The cost of membership to the UNE Landcare group is determined at the first general meeting of Southern New England Landcare Co-ordinating Committee for the year (usually around \$2 for the year). Every cent of your membership fee goes toward paying for liability insurance (administered by Southern New England Landcare). Liability insurance is necessary to cover all members participating in working bees or other on-ground activities. Upon becoming a member, you will receive a receipt of payment and letter of membership that can be used in your portfolio. Paid members are eligible to vote at meetings and elections, and nominate and elect the executive committee.
