Click on the Home tab

Do a search for “torrens system” “indefeasibility of title” (51 results in Laws of Australia, 197 case documents and 23 results in journals)

Click on Laws of Australia and look at several of the results. Look at the search string to see where the results are coming from.

Look at the journal list of hits and refine your search by adding the term statutory exception – this narrows your results to 9 hits.

FirstPoint is a legal research product which helps you find information about Australian case law. FirstPoint comprises valuable Australian case research from a variety of sources including the following:

With FirstPoint you can:

- retrieve a case on a specific topic or point of law using Thomson's classification scheme;
- browse the hierarchical structure of cases using Thomson's classification scheme; and
- view relevant case details such as judges, date of judgment, digest notes for some cases, catchwords, litigation history, cases considered, cases citing, legislation judicially considered and words and cases judicially considered.

Go to the [Legal Databases](#) and select Legal Online from the list.

- There will be several options to choose from including Cases, Commentaries, Current Awareness, Encyclopaedia and Journals.
- Click on the heading **Cases** and you will see Thomson's classification scheme **by topic** on the left hand side of the screen – clicking on the + sign next to each heading and this will expand the contents.

From the list of practice areas click in the box next to **Conveyancing & Property Law**

Do a search for *torrens system* (415 results)

Narrow your search by adding the term *indefeasibility of title* and search within your results. There should be around 119 hits.

Take a look at the results list on the left hand side of the screen

Look at the results under **By Library** and **By Topic** on the left hand side of the screen by clicking on the + sign to expand the contents.
