**RULE FOR THE ELECTION OF CHANCELLOR AND DEPUTY CHANCELLOR**

1. Notice of the election of Chancellor or Deputy Chancellor shall be given by the Secretary of the Council in writing to the Council at least 14 days prior to the election.
2. An election under Section 10(1) or Section 11(1) of the Act shall be conducted by secret ballot.
3. Each nomination of a candidate for election shall:
  - (a) be handed to the Secretary to the Council at the meeting at which the election is to be held;
  - (b) be proposed and seconded by members of the Council together with a statement of support; and
  - (c) be accompanied by written acceptance of nomination by the person concerned.
4. An election to fill the vacancy in the office of Chancellor or Deputy Chancellor may be held prior to the occurrence of the vacancy.
5. If there are two or more candidates for either Chancellor or Deputy Chancellor, voting shall be conducted in the manner approved by the Council for the election of *office bearers* of the Council.
