### **Background**

The appointee will undertake research, manage and provide support to projects within SiMERR, identify funding opportunities, and prepare funding submissions within the context of SiMERR's focus on rural and regional education.

### **Selection Criteria**

- 1) Completion of a PhD or equivalent qualifications and experience in Science, ICT or Mathematics education in rural or regional Australia.
- 2) Track record in scholarly output, research and publication in one of SiMERR's discipline areas.
- 3) Demonstrated ability to conduct research as a member of a team or independently, and to assist with project implementation.
- 4) Appropriate experience in administration, including project management and organizational skills, supervise casual research staff, exercise independence, initiative, and judgement; and to complete tasks with minimum supervision.
- 5) Ability to write literature reviews, research reports and prepare grant applications.
- 6) Demonstrated excellent written and oral communication skills.
- 7) Capacity to liaise effectively with individuals groups within and external to the University.
- 8) Knowledge of OH & S and Equity Issues in the workplace.
