Postgraduate Training in Clinical Psychology at UNE

The discipline of psychology offers two programs, the Master of Psychology (Clinical) and PhD (Clinical Psychology), that train psychology graduates in the professional specialization of clinical psychology. The MPsych(Clin) provides professional training in clinical psychology whilst the PhD(ClinPsych) is a professional research degree which combines the professional training of the MPsych(Clin) with the research training of a PhD. Training in the clinical program is based on the scientist-practitioner model and adheres to the principles of evidence-based practice. A unique area of specialty within the programs is training towards working in independent/private practice.

This is similar to a tenure track Assistant Professor position in North America.

Duties

1. Contribute to teaching in psychology's undergraduate and postgraduate clinical training programs.
2. Provide supervision for clinical psychology students undertaking a placement at the Psychology Clinic.
3. Supervise 4th year and postgraduate student research projects.
4. Pursue an active and productive research program in Clinical Psychology.
5. Contribute to the administration within the Discipline and School
6. Undertake other appropriate duties as required by Head of School.

Selection Criteria

Essential

1. A recognized qualification in Clinical Psychology, and a PhD in Psychology from an accredited psychology program (applicants who are near completion also will be considered).
2. Eligibility for registration with the New South Wales Psychologists Registration Board (<http://www.psychreg.health.nsw.gov.au/>). Gaining and maintaining this registration is a condition of employment.
3. Eligibility for membership of the Australian Psychological Society's College of Clinical Psychologists (<http://www.groups.psychology.org.au/cclin/>).

Desired

1. Previous demonstrated teaching experience at university level.
2. Previous demonstrated experience providing clinical supervision.
