## **LECTURER IN BIOMEDICAL SCIENCES**

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

#### **Essential**

1. Research higher degree at doctoral level in an appropriate field of Biomedical Sciences including cardiovascular / exercise physiology; endocrinology, haematology; immunology; pharmacology; neuroscience; nutrition; and reproduction.
2. Established research record in a field of Biomedical Sciences; and/or demonstrated capacity to develop or join an existing research group in an appropriate area as evidenced by publications, research grants and postgraduate supervision.
3. Experience in and/or demonstrated capacity to undertake, and commitment to undergraduate teaching in human physiology or human health science.
4. Excellent organisational and interpersonal skills, including the ability to relate well to colleagues and students.
5. Commitment to equal opportunity principles
6. Commitment to OH&S issues appropriate to the discipline.

#### **Desirable**

1. Experience in tertiary teaching in a variety of modes, including internal and external (distance) teaching.
2. Experience in or demonstrated capacity to promote and advance the discipline area in both the University and the wider community.
