Essential Criteria

- 1 A PhD or other doctoral qualification in Writing or a closely related discipline area.
- 2 A record of relevant scholarly and professional/industry experience in Writing.
- 3 A record of demonstrable scholarly and professional achievement including research publications.
- 4 Demonstrated expertise in the pedagogy of Writing in higher education.
- 5 Demonstrated ability to teach multiple writing genres and practices at undergraduate and postgraduate levels.
- 6 Demonstrated ability to take on a leadership role in teaching
- 7 Demonstrated ability to participate in the supervision of Honours and higher-degree research students.
- 8 Demonstrated capacity to apply for external competitive research funding.
- 9 Demonstrated ability to communicate effectively and work collegially and productively as a team member.
- 10 Demonstrated capacity to undertake unit/course coordination and School administrative duties.
- 11 A willingness to participate in annual performance planning and review.
- 12 Commitment to EEO and OH&S principles as they relate to the position.

Desirable Criteria

- 1 Ability to undertake teaching and research in related areas of the School.
- 2 Experience in distance education and online teaching.
- 3 Experience in curriculum development.
- 4 Experience in preparing research proposal submissions to external funding bodies for projects relevant to the position.
- 5 Involvement in relevant professional activity.
