Selection Criteria

Essential Criteria

1. A PhD or other doctoral qualification in Media Studies or a closely related field.
2. Demonstrated expertise in and capacity to teach the study of new media technologies at undergraduate and postgraduate levels.
3. Demonstrated expertise in and capacity to teach at least one, and preferably more than one, of the following at undergraduate and postgraduate levels: film studies; television studies; critical and practical study of the news media; advertising and public relations; writing for screen or radio; children's media.
4. Demonstrated ability to supervise Honours and higher-degree research students.
5. Capacity to contribute to flexible teaching and delivery of Media Studies.
6. Ability to undertake relevant curriculum development.
7. A track record in research and publication commensurate with the position.
8. Demonstrated capacity to apply for external competitive research funding.
9. Demonstrated ability to communicate effectively and work productively as a team member.
10. Demonstrated ability to undertake unit coordination and School administrative duties.
11. A willingness to participate in annual performance planning and review.
12. Commitment to EEO and OH&S principles as they relate to this position.

Desirable Criteria

1. Relevant professional/industry experience in the media.
2. Experience in online curriculum development.
3. Experience in preparing research proposal submissions to external funding bodies, for projects relevant to the position.
4. Involvement in professional activity.
