SELECTION CRITERIA

Essential:

Applicants will:

- have a PhD in physical geography or a related field;
- be research active as demonstrated by peer reviewed publications and grant income;
- have experience in undergraduate teaching, developing and delivering high quality coursework curricula;
- have experience in the supervision of post graduate students; and,
- be able to demonstrate their ability to contribute to an interdisciplinary team environment within the context of Geography and Planning.

Desirable:

Applicants will:

- have ability to contribute to the teaching of GIS, data analysis, remote sensing and field work in geography and planning or related fields;
- be able to demonstrate they have a flexible, team oriented approach to teaching and research;
