The Pro Vice-Chancellor - Educational Innovation and Technology will also be responsible for providing academic oversight of the University's partnerships with public institutions, commercial companies and UNE Access Centres.

The University is seeking a strong and innovative leader of people to fulfill this role, with demonstrated expertise in educational technology and a strategic approach during a time of rapid change.
