Procedure:

3. Now complete the Paid Outside Work approval form (on [same website](#) as 2), have it signed by all team members and then approved by your Head of School. The form is also an agreement with your HoS on how much (of the profit) you and any team members will be receiving upon project completion.

Expressions of interest sought from consultants and researchers - Review of phosphorus availability and utilisation in Australian livestock production systems.

Meat & Livestock Australia is seeking expressions of interest from individuals or project teams to undertake a comprehensive review of published and unpublished literature of soil phosphorus availability R&D, and the potential for increased soil phosphorus utilisation in pasture growth. The review will:

-identify gaps in our knowledge of the potential for increasing pasture productivity and/or reducing production costs by

reduced fertiliser use;

- collate all data and report on factors that mediate phosphorus availability and utilisation by plants in the major regional Australian livestock production systems, with a view to providing a sound basis for future research investments;
- critically review the current and potential options for increasing soil phosphorus utilisation in the major pasture and other **agriculture** systems both here and internationally, including any impacts on soil **health** and resilience relevant to productivity.
