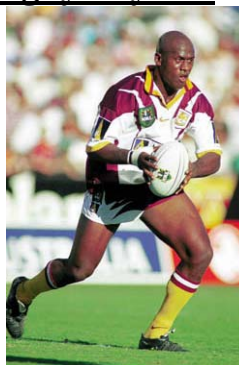
### **AFL**
