Terms and Conditions

1. Introduction

The University of New England has established undergraduate scholarships to support students who have a record of academic achievement, and have been involved in leadership positions in school and the community. Some scholarships are funded by donations or grants from individuals or organisations and may include specific criteria beyond the usual University requirements.

The recipient will commence full-time, on-campus studies at the University of New England in an undergraduate course in the year following application.

The recipient will be required to reside in one of the following colleges: Austin, Earle Page, Drummond and Smith, Duval, Mary White or Robb.

2. Details

Value:	One year's college fees
Number Awarded:	1
Duration:	1 year
Study Mode:	Full-time, on-campus

3. Eligibility

- The applicant must be an Australian citizen or permanent resident as defined by the Commonwealth (refer to www.goingtouni.gov.au) who has applied, via UAC or QTAC, for admission to an undergraduate course at the University of New England.
- A UAI of at least 81 or an ATAR of at least 82.60 (or equivalent) is required.
- The applicant will have applied for accommodation at one of the following colleges: Austin, Earle Page, Drummond and Smith, Duval, Mary White, or Robb.

4. Selection

- The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of academic merit as indicated by the applicant's performance in the NSW HSC, or equivalent.
- The Undergraduate Scholarships Committee will also consider:
 - involvement and leadership in school and community activities; and
 - commitment to the proposed course.

5. Report/s

Number required: 1 (one) – School Principal's Report

6. Closing Date

31 December 2011.

7. Conditions

- Residential scholarships will only be awarded to applicants not receiving other UNE scholarships.
- The applicant will reside in one of the following UNE residences: Austin, Earle Page, Drummond and Smith, Duval, Mary White or Robb.
- The scholarship shall be administered by and awarded on the recommendation of the Committee of College Heads.
- There will be no commitment by the University to employ the recipient.
- The scholarship is intended for the nominated undergraduate course and may not be deferred or transferred without the written approval of the Chair of the Undergraduate Scholarships Committee.
- The scholarship shall comprise a payment of one years College fees.
- The scholarship is payable directly into the recipient's residential account in a lump sum after the first census date (mid-April).
- If you make any changes to your enrolment after receiving your instalment you must notify the Undergraduate Scholarships Officer. If you no longer satisfy the conditions of the scholarship you may be required to repay the instalment.
- Recipients will be required to submit brief reports (by 30th June and 30th November) on their progress with their studies and involvement in sporting, cultural and community activities as well as participation in University life.
- Additional conditions may apply to some scholarships and may vary by scholarship (e.g. specific conditions on eligibility, voluntary work requirements and payment schedules). When offers are made for these scholarships, the recipient will be made aware of specific conditions that apply.
- Any request to vary the conditions of the scholarship must be made in writing and will be determined at the discretion of the Undergraduate Scholarships Committee.
- The recipient will be required to attend the annual scholarships presentation evening, if they are invited to do so, and may be asked to participate in activities to promote this scholarship, including public speaking, donor liaison, media interviews and photographs.
- UNE may change these Conditions on written notice to the recipient.

8. Acceptance of Conditions

- In accepting the Alliance Catering/College Scholarship, the recipient acknowledges that he/she is accepting the terms and conditions outlined above.
- Failure to meet the requirements of these terms and conditions may lead to the termination of the scholarship.
