### Terms and Conditions

#### 1. Introduction

St. Albert's College has established three undergraduate scholarships designed for new students of the University who intend to reside in St. Albert's College and who have a record of high achievement in either academia, sports, community service or cultural activities.

#### 2. Details

Value: **\$2,000 (towards the payment of college fees for one year)**  
Number: **Minimum of 3**  
Duration: **One year**  
Study mode: **Undergraduate, Full-time, On Campus**  
Commences: **Trimester 1**

#### 3. Eligibility

- Australian citizen or permanent resident as defined by the Commonwealth (refer to [www.goingtouni.gov.au](http://www.goingtouni.gov.au))
- Students completing Year 12 in 2011 and gap year/s students
- Intending to reside in St Albert's College

#### 4. Selection

- Evidence of achievement, participation and interest in the area of achievement for which the applicant is applying

#### 5. Closing Date

31 December 2011

#### 6. Other Comments

The Scholar will commence full-time, on-campus, studies at the University of New England in the year following application and must reside in St. Albert's College.

#### 7. Referees

Number required: 1 (one) – School Principal Report

#### 8 Tips when applying for a UNE scholarship

Important points to keep in mind when you are preparing your application:

- Read section 3 of the Terms and Conditions carefully and ensure that you adequately meet the eligibility requirements of the scholarships
- Presentation is very important and ensure that you promote your achievements adequately and positively
