**Terms and Conditions**

**1. Introduction**

The University of New England has established undergraduate scholarships to support students who have a record of academic achievement, and have been involved in leadership positions in school and the community. Some scholarships are funded by donations or grants from individuals or organisations and may include specific criteria beyond the usual University requirements.

The recipient will commence full-time, on-campus studies at the University of New England in an undergraduate degree program in the year following application.

The recipient must reside in Earle Page College.

**2. Details**

**3. Eligibility**

- The applicant must be an Australian citizen or permanent resident as defined by the Commonwealth (refer to [www.goingtouni.gov.au](http://www.goingtouni.gov.au)) who has applied, via UAC or QTAC, for admission to a degree program at the University of New England.
- The applicant will have a record of high achievement in either academia, sports, community service or the performing arts and will intend to reside in Earle Page College.

**4. Selection**

- The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of academic merit as indicated by the applicant's performance in the NSW HSC, or equivalent,

And or

- **One** of the criteria listed below:
  - **Academic** excellence;
  - **Sporting** excellence;
  - **Community service**; or
  - **Performing** arts.
- The applicant should provide a statement supporting their application detailing their achievements in Sporting, Community Service or Performing Arts.

## **7. Conditions**

- The recipient must reside in Earle Page College.
- The scholarship shall be administered by and awarded on the recommendation of the Undergraduate Scholarship Committee.
- There will be no commitment by the University to employ the recipient.
- The scholarship is intended for the nominated undergraduate degree and may not be deferred or transferred without the written approval of the Undergraduate Scholarships Committee
- The scholarship shall comprise a payment of one thousand dollars (\$1,000).
- The scholarship is payable directly to the recipient's residential account in second semester (at the end of August).
- Residential scholarships will only be awarded to applicants not receiving other UNE scholarships.
- Recipients will be required to submit brief reports (by 30<sup>th</sup> June and 30<sup>th</sup> November) on their progress with their studies and involvement in sporting, cultural and community activities as well as participation in University life.
- Any request to vary the conditions of the scholarship must be made in writing and will be determined at the discretion of Undergraduate Scholarships Committee
- The recipient will be required to attend the annual scholarships presentation evening, if they are invited to do so, and may be asked to participate in activities to promote this scholarship, including public speaking, donor liaison, media interviews and photographs.

## **8. Acceptance of Conditions**

- In accepting the New England Mutual/Earle Page College Entrance Scholarship the recipient acknowledges that he/she is accepting the terms and conditions outlined above.
  - Failure to meet the requirements of these terms and conditions may lead to the termination of the scholarship.
