



Access

- All school groups must pre-book before using any part of the facility.
 - Supervision of students is the teachers' responsibility.
 - Where Sport UNE staff is in attendance at a particular event this is in addition to the correct ratio of teachers/students schools are required to provide their students.
 - All students must have parental permission to use the facilities.
- All parents must be informed by the school of the activities the children are undertaking.

Pool

- All school groups will adhere to the Sport UNE policy Guidelines for Aquatic Users.
- Schools must make an assessment of all students' swimming ability irrespective of parental permission for students to participate in swimming or water activities.
- Any student that is found having difficulty swimming by Sport UNE staff will be asked to leave the pool and the teacher informed.
- Students with a low level of swimming ability are encouraged to use back bubbles or approved flotation aids.
- At least one school staff member must have current first aid qualifications and swimming ability.

Gym

- All school groups will adhere to the Sport UNE Gym Participation Policy at all times whilst within the centre.

Group Fitness

- All school groups will adhere to the Sport UNE Group Fitness Participation Policy at all times whilst within the centre.

Courts

- All school groups will adhere to the Sport UNE Tennis Participation Policy, Squash Participation Policy, and the Campbell Hall Participation Policy at all times whilst within the centre.

Outdoor Activities

- All school groups will adhere to Sport UNE Sun Protection Policy at all times.

Cancellations

Cancellations must be made in accordance with Sport UNE's Bookings Cancellation Policy. Cancellation fees may be incurred for late cancellations or non-cancellations.

Change Rooms

- Children under 8 are to be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Children over the age of 8 are to only use same sex change rooms.
- If a child has not been toilet trained please ensure an adult is with them at all times when they are using the toilets. Any mess is the responsibility of the parent to clean up.

Schools are required to abide by all of Sport UNE's policies at all times.

Please note: Failure to comply with the above rules could result in Sport UNE asking a patron to leave the premises, with membership suspension, membership cancellation, and/or permanent restriction from Sport UNE allocated to that patron if deemed serious.
