



Access

- Access to courts is allowed during allocated times.
- Entry must first be granted via the Customer Service Reception desk. Payment must be received and receipted **before** entry is permitted.
- All school groups or bulk bookings must pre-book before using any part of the facility.
- Teachers and group leaders should inform all students/children of each game's rules and modify rules as required to maintain student/child safety and enjoyment.

Game Play

- Players should drink plenty of fluids before, during, and after any game.
- All players should warm up before any game and cool down after any game.
- Appropriate clothing should be worn that allows the evaporation of sweat; minimum clothing is shirt, shorts/skirt, socks and shoes.
- All loose apparel, jewellery and other ornaments that may cause injury must be removed before play starts.
- Long hair, if it is likely to impair vision or become entangled in the equipment, should be secured.
- Only players involved with the match should be on the court during a game.
- Players should not enter other courts to retrieve a ball while play is in progress.
- Players must change ends by walking around the net post, not by going over or under the net.
- If the net or posts require attention (i.e. net sagging), please inform Sport UNE staff.
- All equipment should be inspected prior to use and maintained on a regular basis.
- All users should implement sun safety strategies.
- If a ball goes onto the road wait until there is no traffic about before retrieving the ball.

Change Rooms

- Children under 8 are to be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Children over the age of 8 are to only use same sex change rooms.
- If a child has not been toilet trained please ensure an adult is with them at all times when they are using the toilets. Any mess is the responsibility of the parent to clean up.
