**OPEN ACCESS INFORMATION NOT RELEASED TO THE PUBLIC
DUE TO AN OVERRIDING PUBLIC INTEREST AGAINST DISCLOSURE**

As UNE makes decisions about open access information that may not be disclosed due to an overriding public interest, it will publish this information in the table below.

Under the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009 (GIPA Act)*, when deciding whether or not to release information, government agencies must consider whether there is an overriding public interest against releasing the information.
