The Chancellor	• a robe similar to that worn by the Chancellor of the University of Sydney; black velvet trencher cap with gold tassel and the skull-cap edged with gold.
The Deputy Chancellor	• a robe similar to that worn by the Deputy Chancellor of the University of Sydney; black velvet trencher cap with gold tassel.
The Vice-Chancellor	• a robe and trencher similar to that worn by the Chancellor but trimmed with silver instead of gold.
A Member of the University Council	• the robes of her or his degree or a black gown of the description worn by graduates holding the degree of master, with hood of black cloth lined throughout with dull gold silk; black cloth trencher cap with gold tassel.
Esquire Bedell	• the robes of her or his degree or black Cambridge gown for the degree of master with a hood of gold cloth of the Cambridge doctorate pattern lined throughout with blue silk (BCC 162) and edged with red (BCC 210) and green (BCC 25) silk and black cloth trencher with gold tassel.
Fellow of the University	• black cloth gown similar to that worn by graduates holding the degree of bachelor in the University of Cambridge, black cloth trencher cap, gold silk stole (BCC 114) of width 12.5cm and total length 2.5m, edged to a depth of 2cm with green silk (BCC 25), with the shield of the University emblazoned on the left hand panel 150cm above the end.
Doctor ^{2, 6}	• festal gown of scarlet cloth of the Cambridge doctorate pattern faced with silk the colour or colours of the degree with a narrow edging of gold silk (BCC 114), hood of scarlet cloth lined throughout with silk the colour or colours of the degree and edged to a depth of 5cm with gold silk (BCC 114); black velvet bonnet with gold cord.
Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) ⁶	• festal gown of scarlet cloth of the Cambridge doctorate pattern faced with white silk with a narrow edging of gold silk (BCC 114), hood of scarlet cloth lined throughout with white silk and edged to a depth of 5cm with gold silk (BCC 114); black velvet bonnet with black cord.
Master ^{3, 6}	• black cloth gown similar to that worn by graduates holding the degree of master in the University of Cambridge, black cloth trencher cap, hood of black silk lined throughout with silk the colour of the degree and edged to a depth of 5cm with gold silk (BCC 114).
Bachelor ^{4, 6}	• black cloth gown similar to that worn by graduates holding the degree of bachelor in the University of Cambridge, black cloth trencher cap, hood of black silk lined to a depth of 15cm with silk the colour of the degree and edged to a depth of 4cm with gold silk (BCC 114).
Diplomate ^{5, 6}	• black cloth gown similar to that worn by graduates holding the degree of bachelor in the University of Cambridge, black cloth trencher cap, gold cloth stole (BCC 114) of width 10cm and total length 2.5m with distinguishing colours for level of award arranged as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Graduate Certificate/Graduate Diploma: two 13mm satin ribbons in the distinguishing colour or colours running the length of the stole, the first being 1cm from the outside edge and the second 1cm from the first. ◦ Certificate/Diploma/Advanced Diploma: one 13mm satin ribbon in the distinguishing colour or colours running the length of the stole being 1cm from the outside edge. ◦ Associate Diploma: 13mm horizontal satin ribbon in the distinguishing colour or colours running edge to edge, 30cm from inside edge of mitre.
