Paul Whaley is Systematic Reviews Editor at the journal Environment International (IF 9.6). He is one of the most experienced SR editors in the field of environmental health, handling over 350 manuscripts. These include the WHO Global Air Quality Guideline SRs and the recent WHO/ILO burden of disease SRs for the joint estimates of global burden of disease from occupational environmental exposures. Environment International has a uniquely rigorous process for handling SR submissions. Paul will demonstrate how authors can use these processes as a framework for conducting high quality systematic reviews.
