### Executive Summary

The following report provides a summary of matters discussed at the Academic Board meeting of 13 August 2108 and at the Academic Board Standing Committee meeting of 11 September 2018.

### Key Information

#### Academic Board meeting 13 August 2018

**A. Strategic Discussion - Governance and Management.** The Chair of Academic Board led a strategic discussion regarding governance and management, acknowledging the sometimes blurred lines between the two roles and considering the role of Academic Board members in doing its part, on behalf UNE stakeholders, and considering the UNE objects, functions, to help ensure UNE is meeting or exceeding the minimum threshold standards outlined in the Higher Education Standards Framework.

Members discussed the delegations to the Board and committees, the importance of being able to question ‘can we do this better’ and ‘are we accountable for this decision’ and that the Board and its new membership and structure is functioning well and that things will continue to develop over time.

In a later discussion, the Board also looked at the intersection between the Academic Board and Committees and a number of management committees of the University, to gain a better understanding of the flow of information and decision making process.

**B. Strategic Discussion – Flexibility and Access.** The Pro Vice-Chancellor Academic Innovation, Professor Powles, spoke to the recent research report prepared by Hanover Research and also the results from a student survey relating to the Academic Calendar. He emphasised the importance to students of flexibility when choosing or not choosing to enroll at UNE. He suggested the need to attend intensive schools in Armidale and also the admissions process (time to offer) were also factors in students choosing to enroll at another university.

Board members were pleased to note that UNE’s flexibility and academic quality were rated as ‘good’ to ‘excellent’ by over 90% of students, whether they matriculated at UNE or not. They discussed the Hanover findings, noting flexibility was important, but also that time to provide offers was a more significant reason for not enrolling at UNE and that this might be ‘low hanging fruit’, while other reasons for not enrolling, such as choosing local university or not able to afford, were more difficult to address. Members asked for more granularity of findings to see if there were specific trends within discipline areas and between undergraduate and postgraduate courses – as this better inform the academic response.

The Board also discussed the results of the academic calendar survey and Professor Powles explained that a key take out was the lack of offerings in T3. Students were concerned about the ability to progress their studies at UNE, preferring to undertake 2 units per Trimester, which enabled a part-time student to complete in 4 years. He explained that a summary report was being prepared with the view to proposing a 2020 calendar which allowed slightly longer Trimesters (12 weeks) and which allowed for shorter teaching blocks (6 weeks) within each Trimester which are optional for specifically designed shorter courses.

Members noted the importance of designing pedagogy and materials specifically for online delivery and that successful implementing of shorter study blocks would require a holistic review of systems to support this. Student members provided feedback that communication around expectations and ensuring the units were fit for purpose for the teaching period was a key issue raised by students.

- C. Vice-Chancellor's Report.** The Vice-Chancellor's report provided an update on enrolments and also noted UNE's invitation to bid to establish a full campus in Tamworth, with members interested in exploring how the campus would be developed and focused, should UNE's bid progress as hoped.
- D. Student Report.** The Board considered and endorsed the recommendation from the students to support the further promotion and communication of UNE's guidelines regarding [Teaching and Learning Expectations for Staff and Students](#). The Chair has referred this matter to the Pro Vice-Chancellor Academic Innovation. Comment was made that it is important that staff be supported in the implementation of these guidelines and this would be best be through a staff development framework.
- E. Chair of Teaching and Learning Report.** The report from Professor Jane Conway, Chair of Teaching and Learning Committee included details of the amendments to UNE assessment procedures recently confirmed by flying minute and a copy of the Annual Unit Monitoring report for 2017. A copy of the executive Annual Unit Monitoring report is available within the Convene Document Library. Some of the observations from the 2017 report (Executive Summary) include that:
- overall enrolment compared to 2016 increased by 7.8% in 2017;
  - the trend for average enrolments per unit had been decreasing but increased by 6% in 2017;
  - unit mode attrition was 12.2%, which was a 25.6% decrease from 2016 and the first time attrition has decreased since 2013 (when it was 12.4%);
  - the number of low enrolment unit modes increased by 3.4% since 2016 and this is a continuing trend. Combined with average enrolment increase above, it

indicates that the increase in enrolments per unit is not occurring across the board;

- unit evaluation surveys showed a decrease in student satisfaction across 7 of the 8 criteria, but it was noted that response rates to the survey increased substantially (0.3% to 30.8%) and the average overall satisfaction was steady. Timely Feedback and Constructive Feedback remain the lowest performing areas;
- the long term trend is that overall performance satisfaction for internal students is declining compared to that recorded from external students; and
- overall unit mode pass rate decreased slightly (correspondingly fail rates increased) and the overall grade point average (GPA) decreased by 1% in 2017.

**F. Chair of Curriculum Committee Report.** The Board endorsed to the Vice-Chancellor for approval a number of new courses and significant course amendments, and also considered updated guidelines for the review and approval of course and unit changes. These included:

Course Amendments –

- Graduate Certificate in Commerce (GradCertCom)
- Graduate Diploma in Commerce (GradDipCom)
- Bachelor of Psychology with Honours (BPsych)(Hons)
- Master of Nursing (MN)
- Bachelor of Training and Development (BTD)

New Courses

- Graduate Certificate in Nursing Practice (GCNP)
- Graduate Diploma In Professional Practice (GDPP)

Members discussed the proposed changes including how the academic support arrangements for the concierge service which is offered as part of the Graduate Diploma in Professional Practice, would be managed to ensure compliance with relevant standards. It was confirmed that this would be undertaken within the portfolio of the Pro Vice-Chancellor Academic Innovation.

**G. Chair of Research Committee Report.** Professor Jane Edwards, Chair of Research Committee referred to two substantive matters discussed by the committee, which included the consideration of the recommendations from a recent external review of UNE's human ethics committee (conducted by Dr Mark Hochman), as well considering UNE's response to the revised Australian Code for the Responsible Conduct of Research 2018, which will come into effect from the 1 July 2019. Both of these matters were to be further considered by the committee at coming meetings.

**Academic Board Standing Committee Meeting - 11 September 2018**

- H. Updates regarding Institutional Benchmarks and Academic Delegations.** The Provost and Deputy Vice-Chancellor (PDVC) updated the Academic Board Standing Committee on the progress towards establishing regular reporting on key academic institutional benchmarks, and the review of Academic Delegations. The proposed institutional benchmarks are to be presented to the Academic Board's October meeting and will, in due course, be included in Chair of Academic Board report to Council. The review of Academic Delegations was also well underway and is expected to be completed by the end of the year.
- I. Academic Board Standing Orders.** The standing committee members considered and discussed revised standing orders that would apply to both Academic Board and its Committees, and endorsed the changes to the next Academic Board for approval.
- J. Winchester Report and Management Response.** The Provost and Deputy Vice-Chancellor provided a summary of UNE's responses and actions to the 34 recommendations arising from the Winchester external review of academic governance at UNE. Much of the adopted matters are well in train and a final report is to be provided early next year.
- K. Graduate Research Subcommittee Terms of Reference.** The standing committee members discussed that the previous Graduate Research Subcommittee of the (then) University Research Committee had been replaced by a management committee the "Graduate Research Committee", which was no longer a formal Academic Board subcommittee. As a result the committee **endorsed** a recommendation to the Council that the terms of reference for the old (no longer operating) Graduate Research Subcommittee be rescinded.
- L. Principal Dates 2020.** The Pro Vice-Chancellor Academic Innovation, Professor Powles, discussed a paper regarding the proposed Principal Dates for 2020. The committee discussed the proposed dates for 2020 and agreed to refer the Principal Dates to the next Academic Board meeting.
- M. The NSW/ACT/NT Chairs of Academic Board Conference.** The NSW CoCABS meeting was held at UNE on 7th September. This Committee is entrusted with reporting to NSW Education Standards Authority and the Technical Scaling Committee, as well as the NSWVCC on developments in the sector. The UNE meeting accentuated the value of university collaboration across Australia on governance issues such as academic integrity.

**N. The need for transparency.** The Standing Committee had a free and frank discussion about the advantages in adopting open and clear processes that feed into decision making in the university.
