Terms and Conditions

1. Introduction

Prizes are a method of recognising outstanding performance and endeavour by a student of the University in the fields of academic performance, personal development, social and community contributions and/or sporting prowess.

Prizes are awarded at the discretion of the University and through the generosity of donors, both private and public. Prizes may come in the form of cash, books, society memberships and medals. It shall be a condition of any acceptance of a prize that the University may advertise the first and last name of awardees and those same details may be communicated to the donor. If the donor wishes to provide separate congratulations to the recipient, these shall be coordinated through the Office of Advancement. Address and contact details of recipients shall not be released without their written consent.

2. Details

Number Awarded:	3 annually 1 for first year, 1 for second year and 1 for third year students

3. Eligibility

- The recipient must be an Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander student
- The recipient must be enrolled in a Nursing degree at the University of New England

4. Selection

- The Prize will be awarded on the basis of academic merit as indicated by recent academic records, to the student who, if of sufficient merit, has the highest aggregate in first year, second year and third year.
- The prize will be awarded on the recommendation the Head of the School of Health

5. Conditions

- The Prize is intended for the nominated undergraduate degree and may not be deferred or transferred.
- The Prize is will be paid directly to the student's bank account.
- Additional conditions may apply to some Prizes. When offers are made for this Prize, the recipient will be made aware of specific conditions that apply.

6. Acceptance of Conditions

- In accepting the Prize, the recipient acknowledges acceptance of the terms and conditions outlined above.
