Doctor of Philosophy (PhD)

Entry Requirements

- (a) has a degree of Master (AQF Level 9) with at least 25% research component undertaken at a sufficiently high standard; or
- (b) has a degree of Bachelor with at least upper second class honours (AQF Level 8); or
- (c) has a degree at AQF Level 8 or AQF Level 9 and have adequate research preparation since graduation. Adequate research preparation may be gained by an approved academic course, professional training, during an occupation or through peer reviewed publications; or
- (d) has previously undertaken work of sufficiently high standard towards a higher degree by research (AQF Level 9) in the University but not have submitted it for any degree; and
- (e) has produced documented evidence of capacity to undertake work at the PhD level; and
- (f) has completed and had approved by the Committee a PhD research proposal.

Master of Laws (Research) (LLM)

Entry Requirements

(a) hold a degree of Bachelor with at least second class honours (AQF Level 8) or (AQF Level 9 Masters or AQF Level 10, in Law); or

hold a degree at AQF Level 7 or AQF Level 9 Masters in law leading to admission to legal practice and the equivalent of at least two years full-time, documented, relevant professional experience.

Relevance of the previous degree(s): The completed degree(s) must be in an area that is relevant to the intended PhD, such that the applicant will have an understanding of the body of knowledge relevant to the intended PhD.

Evidence of research ability: Normally based on theses and/or publications prepared as part of previous degrees.

Currency of applicant's knowledge of the discipline: The applicant's degree(s) and/or professional experience must demonstrate that their knowledge of the relevant discipline is current.

Level of commitment: Based on the information presented in this form, complemented by communication with potential supervisors via email or telephone.

English language skills: All applicants must meet the <u>University's English Language Requirements for Admission Rule</u> which includes an IELTS overall score of at least 6.5 with no sub-band less than 6.0.

Completing this form does not guarantee you admission to the Faculty as a research student. Once it has been determined that the applicant has met the relevant UNE entry requirements, they will be advised to contact potential supervisors in the School of Law to discuss their proposal. Applicants will then be invited to submit a full Higher Degree Research application through myUNE, including a more detailed research proposal and referee reports. Admission to Candidature will only be approved once the School of Law has assessed the research proposal as suitable for a higher degree by research; the Faculty has certified that the necessary facilities and appropriate support for the applicant undertaking the proposed program are available; and an appropriate Principal Supervisor and Cosupervisor(s) have been appointed. Please note that if there are no supervisors with sufficient availability or expertise in the proposed topic area, the applicant will not be invited to proceed with a full HDR application
