Use this guide to find the right category for your research activities. Each parent type contains multiple sub-types to help you record your work accurately.



1. Hosting a Visitor (International/ Domestic)



Hosting a Visitor

Record when you hosted visitors at UNE for research activities or collaborations.

- **International Visitor/s** – Visitors from overseas organisations
- **Domestic Visitor/s** – Visitors from Australian organisations



2. Research Supervision and Development



Research Supervision and Development

Record supervision, examination, and mentoring activities not captured in standard workload systems.

- **UNE Honours Supervision** – Supervising UNE Honours students
- **Thesis Examination** – Examining theses (internal or external to UNE)
- **External HDR Supervision** – Supervising PhD/Masters students at external universities
- **Mentoring & Capacity Building** – Formal mentoring of researchers, professionals, or community members

Note: UNE HDR students are already captured in Callista – don't enter them here.



3. External Academic Engagement



External Academic Engagement

Record when you visited other institutions for research activities.

- **Research Visits/Placement** – Short-term visits for collaboration, lab work, or data collection
- **Sabbatical** – Extended research leave at another institution
- **Fellowships/Secondment** – Formal appointments (visiting fellow, researcher in residence)
- **Honorary and Adjunct Affiliation** – Formal honorary or adjunct appointments at other institutions

4. Consultancy



Consultancy

Record paid or formal unpaid consulting where you provided expert advice to external organisations.

5. Publication Peer Review and Editorial Work



Publication Peer Review and Editorial Work

Record your peer review and editorial contributions to publications.

- **Peer Review** – Reviewing manuscripts, book proposals, or journals
- **Editorial Roles** – Editor, associate editor, or editorial board member
- **Conference Proceedings Editor** – Editing conference proceedings published in academic journals

6. Industry, Government or Community Engagement



Industry, Government or Community Engagement

Record engagement activities with non-academic partners.

- **Government Engagement** – Policy submissions, advisory roles, committee participation, expert testimony
- **Industry Engagement** – Collaborative projects, knowledge transfer, industry advisory work (not paid consultancy)
- **Community Engagement** – Public programs, school visits, community workshops, citizen science projects
- **Professional Development Services** – Training/workshops delivered to external professionals (not students)
- **Expert Witness or Advisor** – Testimony, reports, or witness statements based on your expertise

7. Membership



Membership

Record your membership in professional bodies, committees, boards, or networks.

- **Professional Association/Societies** – Membership in disciplinary/professional organisations
- **Boards/Advisory Body** – Serving on boards or formal advisory groups (internal or external)
- **Committee** – Committee membership (internal and external)
- **Network/Collaboration** – Formal research networks or collaborative groups

8. Events



Events

Record events you organised or participated in.

- **Conference** – Academic conferences (as organiser, presenter, or attendee)
- **Workshop** – Smaller focused events for training or knowledge exchange
- **Exhibition/Performances** – Creative works exhibitions, performances, or installations
- **Public Engagement Events** – Science fairs, festivals, open days, discipline-specific outreach

9. Talk or Presentation



Talk or Presentation

Record presentations you gave (not already captured under Events).

- **Keynote/Invited Presentations** – Invited to speak due to your expertise
- **Presentation** – Submitted abstract and selected to present
- **Public Lecture, Debate or Seminar** – Public talks, appearances, or presentations
