

Duration

The course is delivered in 52 weeks (one year).

Full time study for 40 weeks and a break period of 12 weeks between 4 study terms. Each study term is approximately 10 weeks long.

The scheduled contact study per week is 20 hours.

The classes are scheduled per study week for two full days (09 am to 05 pm) and a third half day (either 09 am to 01 pm or 01 pm to 5 pm as scheduled). There is also an additional 15 hours of self-study per study week for students.

Entry Requirements

- » Age: applicants must be 18 years or older at the time of course commencement.
- » Academic: candidates must enter the qualification through one of the following entry points which demonstrate their potential to undertake study at graduate level:
 - » An Advanced Diploma or Diploma qualification relevant to an agrifood industry
 - » Relevant extensive vocational experience in middle management in an agrifood industry at a skill level commensurate with the AQF level VI attributes and criteria
 - » Higher education qualification (e.g. Bachelor Degree), with relevant vocational experience in an agrifood industry
- » English proficiency: overseas applicants are required to demonstrate English language proficiency by one of the following options:
 - Overall English language tests results: IELTS 6.0, with no band less than 5.5, or equivalent on PTE, CAE or TOEFL iBT.
 - » Certificate of completion from an Australian Senior Secondary School
 - » Certificate of completion from an Australian Qualification at a Bachelor's level or above, within the last two years prior to the application
 - » Have completed at least 5 years of study in English medium in one or more of the following countries: Australia, UK, USA, Canada, New Zealand, South Africa, or the Republic of Ireland
 - » Pre-Advanced or Advanced level certificate from an Australian ELICOS provider*
 - » Ironwood Institute internal English test
