

Online professional experience

The Online Professional Experience in this unit is a focused program where you undertake observations of classroom video footage and conduct 'practice analysis'. No attendance in schools is required. These observations sharpen your gaze so that you know what to notice to when you observe teaching in school classrooms. It involves online activities that are linked with observations of video footage.

Time allocation

You need to allocate 10-12 hours per week to this unit. There are 11 weeks of teaching in the unit and your weekly attendance is required in order to pass. There is compulsory attendance which is gauged through your Moodle discussion posts that you make in the website each week. Assessment starts from week 2 in the unit.
