6. E-pals

- 1) Mary O'Connell will send 1) students' names, 2) email addresses, and 3) gender (boy, girl) to the KOR teachers on 7 Mary (Fri), and also a PPT file for the Casual Introduction of Individual Students.

7. Exchange of cultural artefacts with e-pals

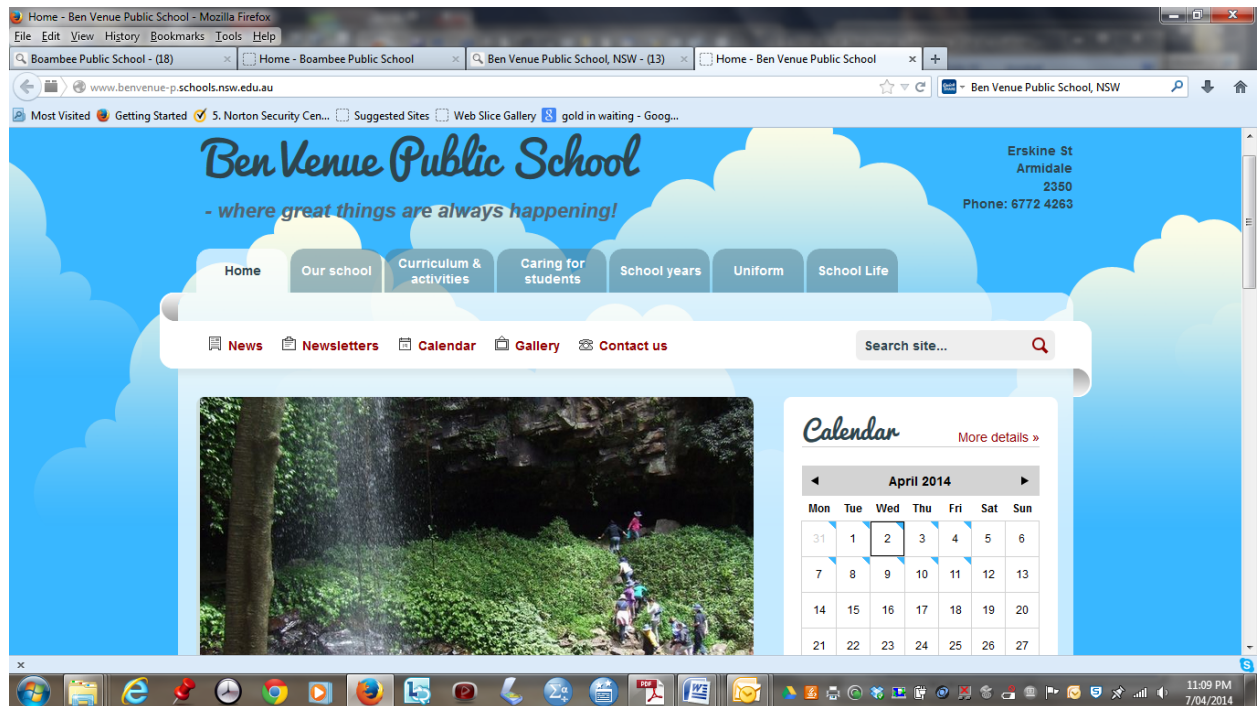
- 1) On 10 Oct (Fri), outside the VC session, students write cards to their e-pals.
- 2) On 17 Oct (Fri), students bring small gifts representing their culture. Teachers put the students' cards and the cultural gifts in a box, and send it by postal mail. The box has to be sent on 17 Oct so that there is sufficient time to receive it before the last VC session on 28 Nov (Fri).
